Re: Operations Department Update

OVERVIEW OF PAST MONTH

- 1. We had 1 leak repair this past month. It was in Redhawk. We had 2 hydrants get hit. One has to be replaced in The Enclave, the other was just repaired in the Colony.
- 2. Crews are doing PRV maintenance in the Colony area. The seasonals are working on hydrants and valves in Promontory.
- 3. Sun Peak well 2 is up and running in our system at about 90 gpm.
- 4. Old Ranch pump station upgrades are continuing. A Nitrogen system is installed and the ceiling is being refurbished.
- 5. Well 2 in Summit Park and the Gulch Well at the Canyons were both pulled. Working on brush and bail and also scheduled to be videoed. Well 5 pump and motor in Summit Park was installed and ready to go if needed. It was also brushed, bailed and videoed. (See pic)
- 6. The Jailhouse well's power was hit by a contractor in the area. Working on repairs.

FOCUS FOR NEXT MONTH:

- 1. Old Ranch pump station improvements-continue with concrete work and ceiling refurbishment.
- 2. PRV maintenance is ongoing in the Colony area. We have 23 stations in the Colony.
- 3. Well repairs.
- 4. Continue with the upsizing of the culinary water piping at the treatment plant.
