Governor Cox Issues a THIRD Executive Order Due to Unprecedented Drought Conditions in Utah

93% of our state is in EXTREME drought

Drought Response Actions

Get to the "root" of it

1. Water less. Deep infrequent watering allows your lawn's root system to deepen.
2. Don't water if it's windy. If wind speed is above 5mph, water will blow where it's not needed and evaporate.
3. Raise your mower. Set your blades at 3-4 inches. Taller grass means deeper roots and helps to shade roots and soil.
4. Repair leaks! Fix leaks as soon as they are detected. Repair heads that have water puddling around them, and adjust sprayers shooting onto the street, driveway, or sidewalks.

Drought Restrictions:

- **NO Watering between 10 AM and 6 PM.**
- **Watering is RESTRICTED to every other day and it is recommended to be done ONLY 2 TIMES PER WEEK.**
- **Wasting Water Violations are being issued.**

We don't know how long the drought will last, but as a community we can control our response. Please help us conserve. **EVERY DROP COUNTS!**

Prioritize irrigation to allow landscapes to "survive not thrive":

1. Trees
2. Shrubs
3. Perennials
4. Annuals
5. Grass/Lawn

Grass is resilient and will enter dormancy during times of drought and recover when conditions improve.
