Re: Technology Department Update

OVERVIEW OF PAST MONTH:

1. We are already ramping up for the irrigation season and have been working with the Operations teams on all the hydraulic flush to waste valves that have been replaced with electrically activated valves at various sources around the District. We have also replaced a few pump control panels that were old and outdated with new, standardized panels with current replacement parts, etc.
2. Kadin continues to work on getting more data into OpenGov and working with Customer Service and the various Ops teams on form and work flows. Kadin and the Engineering team have worked on naming and data standards as well.
3. The transformer replacement/upgrade project at Lost Canyon Booster is going well. The footings for the new wall have been poured and the wall itself should be poured by the time we have our board meeting. The transformer being replaced this spring is the far one in the photo below.



4. Still working on updating the rest of the remote SCADA sites that are using cellular radios to the newest hardware and configurations. As we lose more snow we will have access to the remaining sites and hope to wrap up this project by the end of May.
